Rebuilding the Portishead to Bristol railway

I'm getting in touch to let you know about our latest stage of work to rebuild the Portishead to Bristol railway, including new stations at Portishead and Pill.

Main construction is about to begin. The table below and the attached maps shows upcoming work in your area as we prepare to realign Quays Avenue and build a new roundabout. This will create space for the new station.

The nature of our work means some noise is unavoidable. We're very sorry for any inconvenience and appreciate your patience as we rebuild your railway.

What is happening?	Dates and times of our work
Map Area 1	
Road closure: Quays Avenue will be closed to set up the temporary road layout.	Overnight from 8pm on Tuesday 7 April to 6am on Wednesday 8 April
Road layout change: Quays Avenue will have narrower lanes but two-way traffic will be maintained.	From 6am on Wednesday 8 April until early 2027
Map Area 2	
Pavement closure: The south-side pavement on Harbour Road, closest to our compound, will be closed for the duration of the work.	From Tuesday 7 April until summer 2027

One-way system: A one-way system will be in place on Harbour Road between the roundabout and Newfoundland Way. Traffic will only be able to travel towards Quays Avenue. Temporary traffic lights will be used for emergency and large vehicles.

Diversion route: A diversion route via Station Road and Wyndham Way will be clearly signposted, see map below.

June to November 2026

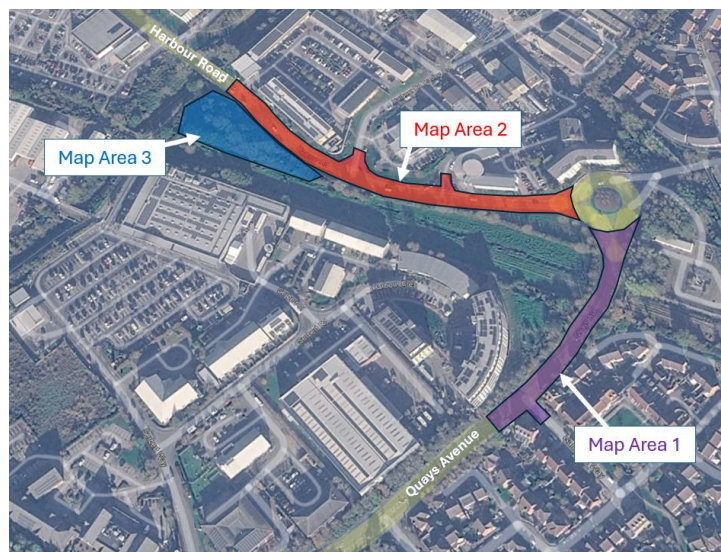
Further phases of traffic management will follow, with the new road layout due to open in spring 2027.
