

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 27 April and 1, 5 and 18 May 2026, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting requirements relating to suitable people, children's safety and welfare, safeguarding policies and procedures, accident or injury, complaints, toilets and intimate hygiene, special educational needs, organising premises for confidentiality and safeguarding, learning and development, suitable people, staff: child ratios, food and drink, risk assessment and information and record keeping.

On 3 June 2026, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found that the provider was not meeting one of the requirements. We issued an action for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Action needed by 1 July 2026:

- ensure safeguarding records are clear and sufficiently detailed.

On 10 June 2026, the provider responded to the action set. We found that the provider had introduced new systems to document and organise all safeguarding records. Leaders have provided training for all staff to ensure they are aware of how to complete clear and sufficiently detailed records.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare action raised.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
