

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 16 May 2025, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting requirements relating to supporting and understanding children's behaviour.

On 22 July 2025, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found that the provider was meeting these requirements. However, during the regulatory visit we found new areas of concern. This means that the provider was not meeting other requirements as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage. In relation to the new areas of concern, we issued an action for the provider to take

Action needed by 15 August 2025

- ensure staff understand the government guidance on sleeping arrangements and take all reasonable steps to ensure children's sleeping arrangements are safe and suitable

On 08 August 2025, the provider responded to the action set. We found that the provider has reviewed their policies and procedures for sleeping arrangements, staff have attended training and staff have shared further information around safer sleeping arrangements with parents.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
