

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 3 October 2025, the provider notified us about matters relating to concerns about children's safety and welfare, whistleblowing, suitable people, and safeguarding policies and procedures. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of significant events.

On 19 November 2025, we carried out a regulatory telephone call visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued actions for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 24 December 2025:

- Ensure all staff are aware of their whistleblowing responsibilities, including how to report concerns about poor or unsafe practice and follow procedures consistently.
- Ensure all staff understand the safeguarding policy and consistently recognise, respond to, record, and promptly report concerns to the DSL.
- Ensure all staff adhere to risk assessments regarding visitors to the setting to keep children safe from harm.

We will monitor the provider's response to ensure the actions are successfully completed.

On 23 December 2025, the provider responded to the actions set. We found that the provider had delivered individualised training sessions to all staff. This supports staff to ensure they are aware of their safeguarding roles and responsibilities, including visitor risk assessments. We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
