

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 7 November 2025 and 10 December 2025, the provider notified us about us about matters relating to the safety and suitability of premises, environment and equipment and health. The notifications mean that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of two significant events.

On 15 & 16 January 2026, we carried out a telephone regulatory call. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued actions for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 30 January 2026:

3.42 ensure that staff arrangements are in place so that children are supervised at all times

3.43 ensure that children are within sight and hearing at all times

3.56 ensure that no one under that age of 16 years is left unsupervised to care for children

3.91 ensure that there are effective risk assessments in place to keep children safe.

On 28 January 2026, the provider responded to the actions set. We found that the provider has revised their risk assessment procedures to ensure that staff are deployed effectively so that children are within sight or sound and adequately supervised. Additional risk assessments are in place to ensure that no one under that age of 17 years is left unsupervised to care for children. All staff have received training to understand their role and responsibility to keep children safe. We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
