

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 17 February 2026, the provider notified us about matters relating to safeguarding policies and procedures, supervision of staff and risk assessment. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of a significant event.

On 21 April 2026, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right.

We found that the provider took prompt action to reassess staff's supervision of children and has assessed the potential risks to ensure children are safe. We found that more robust procedures have been introduced to ensure children's safety, in particular at transition times. A review, followed by refresher training of risk assessment policies and headcount procedures have been shared with all staff to ensure they understand their roles and responsibilities to keep children safe. The provider has also put in place procedures to ensure this knowledge is consistently maintained by staff.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
