

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 16 June 2025, the provider notified us about matters relating to accident or injury. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of a significant event likely to affect the suitability of the provider.

On 14 and 17 July 2025, we carried out regulatory telephone calls. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued actions for the provider to take within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 31 July 2025:

- ensure staff always provide children with adequate supervision to ensure their safety
- ensure that effective risk assessments are carried out to identify all potential hazards on the premises and take appropriate steps to minimise these.

On 25 July 2025, the provider responded to the actions set. We found that the provider has taken steps to ensure that children are closely supervised when transitioning through the setting. Furthermore, the provider has reviewed the settings risk assessments to minimise hazards to children.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
