

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 30 January 2026 and 27 April 2026, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting requirements relating to supporting and understanding children's behaviour and special educational needs.

On 10 June 2026, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. The provider has ensured staff have the skills and knowledge to support children with special educational needs and/or disabilities and that they understand the need for prompt intervention to access funding.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

We publish details of complaints made against childminders, home childcarers and childcare providers where we or the provider have taken action in order to meet legal requirements.
