

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

On the 26 March 2026 the provider notified us about matters relation to safeguarding policies and procedures, concerns about children's safety and welfare, staff:child ratios, health and safety and safety and suitability of premises, environment and equipment. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of a significant event.

On the 20 May 2026 we carried out a regulatory visit. We found that the provider was not meeting some of the requirement. We have served a welfare requirements notice. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 8 June 2026

improve risk assessment procedures to ensure children are not exposed to unnecessary risks and help staff to identify and minimise potential hazards to protect children's safety

ensure children are adequately supervised and are always within sight or hearing.

On 9 June 2026, we carried out an inspection to monitor the pervious actions set and found the provider was still not meeting some requirements. The provision was graded needs attention. The inspection report card sets out the actions the provider was required to take to meet the requirements. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
