

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 16 January 2026, 10 March and 24 March 2026, the provider notified us about matters relating to safety and suitability of premises, environment and equipment, staff-to-child ratios, safeguarding policies and procedures, concerns about children's safety and welfare, suitable people, smoking and vaping, supervision of staff, and information and record keeping. The notifications mean that the provider has met their legal responsibility as set out in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage' to notify Ofsted of a significant event.

On 28 April 2026, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. Leaders have updated the setting's moving around the building policy and new procedures have been put into place. They have provided staff training, to strengthen staff knowledge of the procedures to be used when children are moving around the building. In addition, leaders have strengthened the risk assessment procedures to ensure that hazards to children's safety are identified and removed. Leaders have increased the monitoring of the procedures to ensure they are consistently followed.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to

bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
