Summary of key findings

This provision meets requirements

- The provider demonstrates, through discussion, a strong understanding of creating an inclusive play environment. They explain how they plan activities that engage all children, address individual needs and ensure every child feels valued and supported in their play.
- The provider highlights the importance of developing strong partnerships with parents and carers while maintaining open communication. They explain that this approach helps them understand children's backgrounds and individual needs. The provider also values gathering feedback from both parents and children to continuously enhance the club's provision.
- The provider is knowledgeable about strategies to support children's behaviour effectively. They emphasise the value of setting clear, agreed rules to help children understand expectations. The provider also highlights the importance of regularly monitoring children's well-being to ensure they feel safe and secure.
- The provider recognises the importance of working closely with the schools that children attend. They understand that effective collaboration with other professionals involved in children's care supports continuity and ensures that children's needs are consistently met.
- The provider recognises the importance of ongoing staff training to support professional development. They explain that by incorporating staff feedback, they regularly evaluate the club's provision to ensure continuous improvements and enhance the quality of care for children.
- Through discussion, the provider emphasises the importance of promoting children's health and well-being. They explain that by providing healthy and nutritious snacks and reviewing practices with staff feedback, they ensure children's dietary needs are met and positive eating habits are encouraged.

There were no children in the early years age range present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no early years children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
