

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 14 May 2025, the provider notified us about matters relating to qualifications, training, support and skills, staff:child ratios, safety and suitability of premises, environment and equipment. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundations stage to notify Ofsted of significant information.

On 24 June 2025, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting one of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. The provider has reviewed and implemented appropriate risk assessment procedures to ensure children's safety.

In addition, we found the provider was not meeting another requirement. We have issued an action for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 27 June 2025:

- provide training to ensure staff have appropriate knowledge and understanding of how to deal with health emergency situations in a correct way, to ensure children's safety.

On 4 July 2025, the provider responded to the action set. We found that the provider had provided further training opportunities, and put in place effective monitoring strategies, to ensure staff have the correct and consistent knowledge and understanding of how to deal with emergency situations. These measures have improved safety for children. We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our

responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
