

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 26 July 2025, the provider notified us about matters relating to suitable people, safeguarding policies and procedures, safeguarding training and changes that must be notified. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of a significant event which is likely to affect the suitability of a person who cares for, or is in regular contact with children on the premises.

On 28 August 2025, we received further concerns that the provider was not meeting requirements relating to health, special educational needs, key person and information and record keeping.

On 13 October 2025, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued actions for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 30 January 2026:

- provide staff with effective and specific support and training to develop their professional skills to ensure they are clear about their roles and responsibilities and implement procedures consistently
- ensure that staff deployment is effective to provide all children at the setting with adequate care and to meet their individual needs.

On 30 January 2026, the provider responded to the actions set. We found that the provider completed supervisions of all staff and conducted a training day for curriculum, safeguarding and behaviour management. The provider has ensured that there are daily deployment checks put in place and that senior team members are deployed in each room to oversee practice. This support children's well being and safety at the setting The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
