

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at <http://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2>. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 27 May 2025, the provider notified us about matter relating to safeguarding policies and procedures, safeguarding training, health, safety and suitability of premises, environment and equipment and information and record keeping. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of a significant event.

On 6 and 7 November 2025, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider had failed to notify Ofsted of the appointment of a new trustee which is a requirement of their registration. We issued an action for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Action needed by 21 November 2025:

- ensure that the appropriate suitability checks are completed for new trustees of the charity

On 12 November 2025, the provider responded to the action set. We found that the provider had followed the correct procedures to allow all trustees suitability to be assured. We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to

bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
