

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at <http://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2>. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 25 January 2026 and 11 March 2026, the provider notified us about matters relating to health, staff: child ratios, information and record keeping, safety and suitability of premises, environment and equipment and paediatric first aid. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage' to notify Ofsted of a significant event which involved a child who required medical attention.

On 20 May 2026, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found that the provider had not met one of the requirements. We issued an action for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Action needed by 3 June 2026:

- ensure staff understand their roles and responsibilities to accurately record any accident or injury and that parents are informed on the same day or as soon as reasonably practicable.

On 2 June 2026, the provider responded to the action set. We found that the provider had delivered training to all staff on accident and injury procedures to ensure accuracy and to address inconsistencies. Staff have also revisited details of acceptable first-aid treatment recording and feedback to parents. All staff have read and signed to confirm understanding of the accident and well child policy. We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services

we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
