

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 01 April 2025, the provider notified us about an incident relating to safeguarding policies and procedures. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of significant events.

On 27 May 2025, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. All staff have reviewed the safeguarding policies and procedures, and additional training has been implemented where appropriate.

Additionally, during the regulatory visit on 27 May 2025, we found new areas of concern. This means that the provider was not meeting other requirements as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage.

In relation to the new areas of concern, we issued an action for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 10 June 2025:

- take all reasonable steps to support staff to assess risk and prevent unauthorised persons from entering the premises.

On 9 June 2025, the provider responded to the action set. All staff have received refresher training regarding operating the intercom system. Additionally, the provider has reviewed and updated risk assessments to prevent unauthorised persons from entering the premises.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
