

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at [www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2](http://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2). If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 14 April 2025, the provider notified us about matters relating to supporting and managing children's behaviour. On 24 April 2025, we received concerns about matters relating to the same requirements. In addition, on 12 May 2025, the provider notified us about matters relating to staff: child ratio. These notifications mean that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of any significant event which is likely to affect the suitability of the early years provider to look after children.

On 2 June and 9 June 2025, we carried out regulatory telephone calls. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. The provider has put in place robust procedures to ensure full safety checks of outside areas are conducted by staff and that regular headcounts of children occur throughout the day. This ensures children safety and welfare.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

### **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
