

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 23 May 2025, the provider notified us about matters relating to safer eating. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of a significant event. We found that they reviewed their procedures and risk assessments around safe eating.

On 9 June 2025, we received a further notification about staff: child ratios. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of a significant event. We found that the provider had taken steps to ensure that all staff understand their responsibilities to ensure that children in their care are supervised at all times.

On 12 September 2025, we completed a regulatory visit to explore how the provider meets the requirements. During the visit, we found that the provider had failed to notify Ofsted of a significant event, which is a requirement of their registration. However, we also found that the provider has taken effective steps to develop how they monitor the practice of the senior staff team.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
