

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 15 April 2026, the provider notified us about matters relating to safeguarding policies and procedures, concerns about children's safety and welfare and other legal duties. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage' to notify Ofsted.

On 9 June 2026, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting one of the requirements. We have issued an action for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Action needed by 22 June 2026:

- ensure those with lead responsibility for safeguarding have secure skills and knowledge to implement the settings safeguarding policy on an ongoing basis.

On 19 June 2026, the provider responded to the action set. The provider has ensured those with lead responsibility for safeguarding have attended refresher training to improve their knowledge of safeguarding procedures. They have held supervisions with designated safeguarding leads to ensure they understand and implement the safeguarding policy on an ongoing basis.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare action raised.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
