

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the [Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage](#). If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 6 February 2026, we received concerns that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements 3.76 special educational needs, 3.41 key person, 3.77 accident or injury, 3.42 staff: child ratios, 3.86 toilets and intimate hygiene, 3.83 outdoor access, 3.81 indoor space requirements and 3.9 concerns about children's safety and welfare. On 16 June 2026, we carried out a regulatory visit. Following this visit, we have issued actions for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

■ Actions needed by 30 June 2026:

ensure all required records, including records of staff qualifications are accessible and available to view on request

complete effective risk assessments to identify and remove or minimise any hazards to children and to ensure all areas are kept clean, hygienic and free from rubbish.

On 26 June 2026, the provider responded to the actions set. We found that the provider had updated their records to ensure required documentation is accessible and available to view. They have reviewed their risk assessments and reinstated regular checks to ensure any hazards are identified and removed, and all areas of the nursery are suitable for children. We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
