

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 12, 16 and 24 December 2025, the provider notified us about matters relating to safeguarding policies and procedures; suitable people; staff: child ratios; medicines; accident or injury; safety of premises; risk assessment and other legal duties. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of a significant event.

On 13 January 2026, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued actions for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 20 January 2026:

- ensure staff are deployed effectively to meet the needs of all children and ensure their safety
- ensure records are easily accessible and available for inspection

We will monitor the provider's response to ensure the actions are successfully completed.

On 20 January 2026, the provider responded to the actions set. We found that the provider had taken action to ensure staff are deployed effectively. They have reviewed daily routines, implemented new procedures and updated staff knowledge on the policies and procedures of the setting. The provider has implemented new procedures to organise and centralise records within the setting. We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services

we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
