

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at [www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2](http://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2). If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On the 16 April 2025, 02 July 2025 and 07 July 2025, the provider notified up about significant events (Staff:child ratio, Suitable people, Concerns about children's safety and welfare). The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of a significant event.

On 23 July 2025, we carried out a regulatory telephone call and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements relating to staff:child ratios and had taken action to put this right. The provider has reviewed and improved the risk assessment procedures when children are transitioning from indoors to outdoors. They now also ensure that staff carry out a robust check of the garden before external doors are closed. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

### **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
