

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 12 December and 23 December 2025, the provider notified us about matters relating staff:child ratios, concerns about children's safety and welfare, safeguarding policies and procedures, safety of premises, risk assessment and sleeping arrangements. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of any significant events.

On 26 January 2026, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued actions for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 9 February 2026:

- ensure that staffing arrangements consistently meet the needs of all children and keep them safe, particularly staff deployment during transitions and outdoor play, so that staff are positioned effectively and able to supervise children safely
- ensure risk assessments are robust, regularly reviewed and implemented effectively, particularly in relation to fire evacuation procedures and staff deployment.

On 3 February 2026, the provider responded to the actions set. We found that the provider had improved their knowledge and understanding of fire risk assessment procedures. Furthermore, the provider had reviewed training and policies relating to staff deployment expectations, staff communication during transitions and regular monitoring.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services

we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.
