

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 11 June 2025, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting requirements relating to safety and suitability of premises, environment and equipment. On 17 June 2025, the provider notified us about matters relating to the same requirements.

On 3 July 2025, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. The provider had reviewed their procedures and provided further training for staff to refresh their knowledge. However, we found the provider was not meeting one of the requirements. We have issued an action for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 11 July 2025:

- ensure that risk assessments identify aspects in the environment and influence staff practice, specifically regarding sensory activities.

On 9 July 2025, the provider responded to the action set. We found that the provider had updated their risk assessment relating to sensory play experiences for children. We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare action raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
