- The leadership and management team is effective in ensuring staff suitability. Managers effectively monitor the quality of care and interaction, and safeguarding procedures. They successfully promote ongoing self-evaluation to drive continuous improvement.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. All My Friends After School & Holiday Club at Hucclecote registered in 2012. It operates from a church hall in Hucclecote, Gloucester. The club opens each weekday during term time from 3pm to 6pm and from 8am to 6pm during school holidays. There are 13 members of staff, of whom 10 hold appropriate childcare qualifications at level 3 or level 4.
