

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 15 October 2025, the provider notified us about matters regarding staff: child ratios. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of a significant incident.

On 14 November 2025, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued actions for the provider to take.

Actions needed by 28 November 2025:

- implement robust monitoring of risk assessments and ensure that staff are effectively managing risks to maintain a safe environment for children
- improve the arrangements for monitoring staff practice to identify areas of improvement required and strengthen personal effectiveness
- ensure staff maintain an accurate record of children's attendance.

On 28 November 2025, the provider responded to the actions set. We found that the provider had reviewed and strengthened their risk assessments alongside staff attending further training to improve their knowledge. In addition, the provider had increased arrangements to monitor staff practice to strengthen the oversight of provision and ensure information and records are successfully maintained. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
