Summary of key findings

This provision meets requirements

- The management team take a proactive approach to the running of the club. They regularly reflect on the service it provides. For instance, annual satisfaction surveys help staff to engage with parents and find out their needs and wishes for the club.
- Staff understand the importance of teaching children about healthy lifestyles, such as being physically active, healthy eating and following good hygiene routines.
- Staff have high expectations for children's behaviour. Staff explain how they help children to develop positive relationships and how they incorporate sharing, turn-taking, being kind and respect for others into daily routines and activities.
- Staff gather important information from parents prior to their children starting. This helps to ensure children's individual needs, such as medical and dietary requirements, are met. Staff understand the importance of working in partnership with parents and the host school that children attend so that they can share relevant information about the children.
- Staff understand the importance of providing an inclusive setting. They value the different life experiences children bring with them and have appropriate arrangements to ensure different cultural events are respected and valued. This helps children develop an understanding of the wider world and learn about the similarities and differences of others.
- Staff understand their roles and responsibilities in keeping children safe and what action to take if they had a concern about a child's safety or well-being. Staff have suitable knowledge of the signs that a child may be at risk of harm or neglect.
- The provider has robust recruitment arrangements and explains how she keeps staff's knowledge up to date. For example, all staff complete a thorough induction programme, mandatory training and have regular discussions to keep their skills refreshed. This ensures that all new staff understand their roles and can implement the policies effectively. All staff are enthusiastic, motivated and reflect regularly on practice.

There were no children in the early years age range present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no early years children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
