

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundationstage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 20 January 2025, the provider notified us that a child suffered an accident at the setting. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of changes that must be notified to Ofsted.

On 24 January 2025, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We issued actions for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

On 28 January 2025, the provider responded to the actions set. We found that the provider had improved the security of the building, including locking interior doors when other user groups are using the same premises. Those who form the committee have submitted required information to enable Ofsted to check their suitability. The information gathered suggests that the provider is now meeting the requirements of their registration. We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Actions needed by 30 January 2025:

- ensure that there are suitable arrangements in place to maintain the security of the premises and unknown people cannot access the provision where childcare is taking place

- ensure that all individuals who form the committee provide Ofsted with the necessary information to help confirm their suitability to work with children.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
