

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 3 July 2024, we carried out an inspection and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements. The inspection report sets out the actions the provider was required to take to meet the requirements.

On 20 August 2024, we carried out a regulatory visit. The focus of the visit was to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare actions, raised at their last inspection.

We found that the provider took steps to ensure that all staff had up to date knowledge of safeguarding matters, including reporting procedures in line with the local safeguarding partnership procedures. The provider has taken steps to ensure that all staff receive effective induction training to help them understand their roles and responsibilities to improve the quality of education for all children. Effective coaching is provided to staff to help improve their knowledge of the curriculum. The key-person approach is now consistently used to effectively meet children's individual needs and to build relationships with their parents. The provider ensures that there is a named deputy who is capable to take over in the absence of the manager. At the visit, we observed that staff were able to support and manage children's behaviour in an appropriate way. The provider has improved systems of recording and sharing relevant information with parents and other agencies.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services

we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
