 - The event will be taking place on Stratford Waterfront – in front of the V&A East Museum and Sadler's Wells East, there are also additional activities within the Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park – South Park.

Noise Management: Every effort will be made to make sure that the noise from the event is controlled. There will be a team of specialist noise consultants working on the events to maintain the agreed limits set by the local authority.

To ensure that the event operates within the sound limits set by the local authority, please note there will be sound checks intermittently taking place on Saturday 11 July between 10:00am - 12:00 noon and again on Sunday 12 July between 10:00 am -12:00 noon.
